1. Residents are hereby advised that, with immediate effect, the following prices will apply for the sale of oils etc., at Swartkops Garage.

2. The following limitations on sales at Swartkops Garage have been introduced in an effort to curb any abuse of privileges being enjoyed by all residents :
- 2.1 Contractors and visitors may only purchase up to 5 litres of oil.
- 2.2 C.D.M. personnel purchasing in excess of 5 litres of oil must record their names in a register provided for this purpose.
- 2.3 Contractors and visitors requiring extra petrol in a container are restricted to 25 litres.
- 2.4 C.D.M. personnel will be supplied with their extra petrol requirements, but no single container larger than 25 litres will be filled, and anyone purchasing more than 25 litres of extra petrol will have their name, employee computer number and vehicle registration number recorded in a register.

Residents are advised that it is not permissible to store petrol on Company property as this constitutes a hazard to the safety of others.
